**PLANS, TRAINING, RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT SECTION**  
**G.O. 306.1**

I. PURPOSE

The Plans, Training, Research and Development Section (PTRD) conducts the Department's training and research activities to include research for new equipment and techniques, development of training courses, reviewing and evaluating the training needs of the Department and the development of immediate and long-range training programs.

II. POLICY

- A. It is the policy of this Department to provide for the complex demands for services and declining public resources, which require the careful research of operational alternatives, and to plan future programs.
- B. Because law enforcement is constantly changing, all employees will be afforded opportunities for training in areas affecting the skills, knowledge and abilities of their current or anticipated assignments. Training may take several different forms, but all require a combination of departmental support and a personal commitment towards the common objective of enhanced police performance and service to the community.

III. FUNCTION

- A. The Training effort will be directed toward and related to the development of skills, knowledge and abilities of both sworn and civilian personnel enabling them to;
  - 1. Understand and perform effectively in their current assignment.
  - 2. Acquire additional or specialized skills applicable to their current assignment, future assignment or promotion.
  - 3. Develop and enhance communication skills.
  - 4. Develop and enhance interpersonal/managerial skills.
  - 5. Keep abreast of changes in the field of law enforcement.
  - 6. Provide a common basis for evaluation of job performance.

IV. ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE

A. **Section Commander**

Commander of PTRD shall be an officer holding the rank of Lieutenant and reports directly to the Assistant Chief of Support Services.

B. **Sergeant**


Two Sergeants are assigned to the PTRD Section and report to the Section Commander.

C. **Police Officer III**

Two police officer III's are assigned to the PTRD Section and each are assigned to a PTRD Sergeant.

D. **Office Operations Assistant**

The PTRD Office Operations Assistant shall be responsible to the Lieutenant.
